

**TOWN OF INUVIK
BY-LAW #2081/REC/02**

**A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF INUVIK IN THE
NORTHWEST TERRITORIES TO ESTABLISH PROCEDURES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE
INUVIK FITNESS CENTRE**

WHEREAS pursuant to Sections 169 and 104 of the Cities, Towns and Villages Act of the Northwest Territories, R.S.N.W.T. 1988, c. C-8, and subsequent amendments thereto, which state:

- 104.** A council may, by by-law, provide for the establishment and operation of recreation programs, services and facilities.
- 169.** A council may, by by-law, provide for the establishment, levy and collection of charges for services provided by the municipal corporation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Inuvik, in Council duly assembled, enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE

1. This by-law may be cited as the “Fitness Centre By-law”.

INTERPRETATION

2. In this by-law:
- (a) “**Council**” means the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Inuvik in the Northwest Territories;
- (b) “**Fitness Centre**” means the room located on the second floor of the Midnight Sun Recreation Complex which houses fitness equipment;
- (c) “**Midnight Sun Recreation Complex**” means the Town owned and operated recreation facilities located on Lot 6, Block 21, Plan 3420 in the Town of Inuvik in the Northwest Territories;
- (d) “**Membership Fee**” means the fees charged for use of the fitness centre; and,
- (e) “**Town**” means the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Inuvik in the Northwest Territories.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

3. Anyone using the fitness centre must hold a current membership obtained from the Town of Inuvik and shall fill out a waiver form as set out in **Schedule A** attached to and forming part of this by-law.
4. The facility will be open to members on a twenty-four hour per day, seven days per week basis.
5. All members must sign in prior to using the fitness centre.
6. All members must show respect for other members and equipment at all times.

7. All members must treat the fitness centre with care and record any damages to the fitness centre in the communication book located inside the fitness centre.
8. All members are aware that they are using the facility at their own risk.
9. All members must ensure that equipment is wiped off after each use.
10. No outdoor footwear will be worn inside the fitness centre.
11. No one under the age of 13 years will be permitted in the fitness centre. Youths aged 13 -15 can use the facility **ONLY** when accompanied by an adult.
12. Anyone caught violating the above rules in any way will be asked to leave the facility and a suspension will be issued.

3. All memberships purchased
 - (a) Are NOT refundable

4. NSF cheques returned will result in a membership suspension and a \$20.00 service charge will be levied. Memberships will resume (from original date) once the membership is paid in full.
5. In the event that the member continues to use the fitness facility after his/her membership has expired, the member acknowledges that the terms of the contract are still in effect, and membership payment is retroactive to the termination date of the previous contract.
6. Maintenance and repair may make it necessary for the centre to be closed or for restricted use of the facility. Memberships will not be suspended or reduced during the time when facilities are not available.

The fitness centre has the unqualified right to make rules and regulations respecting the operation of the centre, which each member agrees to abide by:

- (a) Proof of membership **MUST** be presented when requested by Town and MSRC staff.
- (b) Street shoes and boots are to be removed at the front entrance. Proper attire such as t-shirts and gym shoes are to be worn in the fitness area at all times, **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- (c) Weights are to be removed from the bars and machines and placed in the appropriate place immediately after the exercise is completed. Do not drop weights on the floor.
- (d) Each member **MUST** swipe his/her own card when entering the building; no person without a membership is to enter the fitness centre at any time. Any member allowing non-members access to the facility will be asked to leave and will have their membership suspended.

NOTICE OF RELEASE & WAIVER

As a condition of the use of the facilities and equipment by members, the undersigned user voluntarily assumes all risk of accident, injury or damage to person or property and does hereby release and forever discharge MSRC Fitness Centre/Town of Inuvik from any and all claims to him/her, or to his/her property. The member also understands that if caught vandalizing, abusing or misusing any equipment or the facility in a way that it was not intended for, the member will be suspended either temporarily or indefinitely, depending on the situation.

The MEMBER has read and **UNDERSTANDS** every word of this release and waiver.
