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Located in the Western Arctic with a population just under 3,400 residents, Inuvik is a close-knit community that balances traditional and modern living, where the historic endeavors of the Gwich'in and Inuvialuit peoples are the foundation for the cultural mosaic of our community, and our diversity is one of Inuvik's greatest strengths.

We are located on the banks of the Mackenzie River, which flows to the Arctic Ocean. This river, along with its hundreds of lakes and streams, make up a remarkable ecosystem known as the Mackenzie Delta. Take a drive on the Dempster Highway to cross the Arctic Circle and traverse mountain ranges to the south or take a drive on the all-season Inuvik to Tuktoyaktuk Highway to the edge of the Arctic Ocean. And in case you're

not looking to drive all that far, Inuvik is also home to the longest runway above the Arctic Circle in Canada, and hosts three airlines with regular service between Inuvik and the rest of Canada.

As the third-largest community in the Northwest Territories, Inuvik is the major commercial and administrative centre for the Beaufort Delta and serves as the home base for many of the key services in the region. With our many unique and wonderful community festivals and events – the Great Northern Arts Festival, Muskrat Jamboree, and Arctic Development Expo to name a few – our first-class recreation programs and exciting outdoor adventure opportunities, there is something for everyone to do in and around town. Summer or winter, hike or snowshoe the Boot Lake Trail; try Nordic skiing with the Inuvik Ski Club; golf under the midnight sun at Roads End Golf Course; or fish and explore the Mackenzie River.

Inuvik has a diverse population and offers a variety of modern amenities and visitor attractions, and I hope that throughout your stay you have opportunity to chat with local people and elders. If you're looking to explore a bit further afield, our local tour operators are both knowledgeable about the region and offer a wide variety of ways for you to experience the spectacular beauty of our region during your stay.
