A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF INUVIK IN THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES TO PROVIDE FOR THE PARTIAL ROAD CLOSURE OF COUNCIL CRESCENT ROAD.


A council may, pursuant to the Cities, Towns and Villages Act, R.S.N.W.T. 1988, c. C-8, s. 75 pass By-Laws to close municipal roads; and

WHEREAS Council deems it desirable to close a portion of certain municipal road within the municipal boundaries;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Town of Inuvik session duly assembled enacts as follows:

- 1. The portion of the municipal road known as Council Crescent Road within the Town of Inuvik, as filed on a plan of survey in the Land Titles Office under number 228 and illustrated on Schedule 'A' attached to and forming part of this by-law, is thereby closed.
- 2. This by-law shall come into effect upon the final passing thereof.
