

**TOWN OF INUVIK  
BY-LAW #1799/UTIL/00**

**A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF INUVIK IN THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES TO AUTHORIZE ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE GOVERNMENT OF THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES FOR THE TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP OF THE WATER, SEWER AND UTILIDOR SYSTEM TO THE TOWN OF INUVIK**

**WHEREAS** pursuant to Section 130 (1), subsection (1), parts 1 to 5; Sections 78-79; and, Sections 89-90 of the Cities, Towns and Villages Act, R.S.N.W.T. 1988, c. C-8, and subsequent amendments thereto, which state:

130. (1) A council may, by by-law, authorize the municipal corporation to enter into a community agreement with the Government of the Northwest Territories delegating to the municipal corporation the authority and responsibility for the administration and delivery of any service or program of the Government of the Northwest Territories specified in the agreement.
  - (2) A community agreement may provide a municipal corporation with the authority to administer and deliver a service or program within or outside the boundaries of the municipality, or for other communities in a region.
  - (3) A municipal corporation has, subject to the terms and conditions of a community agreement, the power to administer and deliver any service or program delegated to the municipal corporation by the community agreement and, for greater certainty, the administration and delivery of such a service or program in accordance with the community agreement is deemed, for the purposes of this Act, to be a municipal purpose.
  - (4) Where provided for in a community agreement, a council may, by by-law,
    - (a) establish a board or commission to administer all or part of a program or service delegated to the municipal corporation under the community agreement; and
    - (b) define the powers and duties of the board or commission established under paragraph (a).
  - (5) An agreement similar in nature and purpose to a community agreement that was entered into before the coming into force of this section is deemed to be a community agreement entered into under this section. S.N.W.T. 1997, c.5, s.2(11).
78. A council may, by by-law, provide for the establishment of
- (a) a sewage system to collect, convey and dispose of sewage; and
  - (b) a drainage system to collect, convey and dispose of surface and other waters.
79. A council may, by by-law, provide for the operation, maintenance and alteration of a sewage or drainage system established or acquired by the municipal corporation.
89. A council may, by by-law, provide for the establishment of a water distribution system for the supply of water for drinking and other purposes in the municipality.
90. A municipal corporation may, by by-law, provide for the operation, maintenance and alteration of a water distribution system established or acquired by the municipal corporation.

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Inuvik deems it desirable, necessary and in the interest of residents of the Town of Inuvik to enter into a community agreement with the Government of the Northwest Territories for the transfer of the ownership of the water and sewer utilidor system to the Town of Inuvik, effective April 1, 2000;

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**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Inuvik in Council duly assembled enacts as follows:


1. The Mayor and Senior Administrative Officer are hereby authorized on behalf of the Town of Inuvik to enter into a Community Agreement with the Government of the Northwest Territories for the transfer of ownership of the water and sewer utilidor system to the Town of Inuvik, pursuant to the Community Agreement as set out in **Schedule "A"** attached to and forming part of this by-law.
2. This agreement will come into force and effect on April 1, 2000.

READ A FIRST TIME THIS 8<sup>th</sup> DAY OF March, 2000 A.D.

READ A SECOND TIME THIS 8<sup>th</sup> DAY OF March, 2000 A.D.

READ A THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 22<sup>nd</sup> DAY OF March, 2000 A.D.
