

**TOWN OF INUVIK  
BY-LAW #2167/O+C/03**

**A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF INUVIK IN THE  
NORTHWEST TERRITORIES FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING A PORTION OF A  
ROAD**

**WHEREAS** pursuant to Section 75, subsections (1) and (2) and Section 77 of the Cities, Towns and Villages Act of the Northwest Territories, R.S.N.W.T. 1988, c. C-8, and subsequent amendments thereto, which state:


75. (1) A Council may, by by-law, provide for the opening and closing of municipal roads in accordance with this Act.
- (2) No municipal corporation shall close a municipal road if it prevents a person from entering or leaving his or her real property or residence, unless the municipal corporation provides the person with
- (a) reasonable compensation; and,
  - (b) other convenient means of access.
77. Before a council gives third reading to a by-law that will open, establish, close, widen, divert or dispose of a municipal road, the council shall
- (a) give public notice of the proposed by-law at least two weeks in advance; and,
  - (b) hear any person, or representative of the person, who claims to be affected by the by-law and who wishes to be heard.

**AND WHEREAS** the portion of the road allowance is not required for municipal purposes, and the Town of Inuvik deems it desirable to close that portion of the road allowance, acquire title to the land, and subsequently dispose of it by sale to an adjacent property owner;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Inuvik, in Council duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That all that portion of the road on plan 1217 Inuvik, lying within Lots 82 to 90 and Utilidor Right-of-Way, Block 70, and Lot 54, Block 71, Inuvik as shown on a plan under item number 2003-18-030.
2. That the Mayor and Senior Administrative Officer of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Inuvik, or their lawful designates, are hereby authorized in the name and on the behalf of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Inuvik, to execute all such forms of application, deeds, indentures and other documents as may be necessary to give effect to this by-law and to affix thereto the corporate seal of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Inuvik as the act and deed thereof, subscribing their names in attestation of such execution.
3. This by-law will come into effect upon the day of its final passage.
