
**A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF INUVIK
IN THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES TO ACQUIRE REAL PROPERTY**

WHEREAS pursuant to the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*, S.N.W.T. 2003, C.22, section 53, subsections (1), and (3) and subsequent amendments thereto which state:

53. (1) A municipal corporation may, for a municipal purpose,
- (a) acquire real property;
 - (b) use, hold or develop real property owned by the municipal corporation; and
 - (c) subdivide, in accordance with the *Planning Act*, real property owned by the municipal corporation.
- (3) A municipal corporation may not acquire real property unless
- (a) council has made a land administration bylaw and the disposition is made in accordance with the land administration bylaw; or
 - (b) the disposition is specifically authorized or approved by a bylaw.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary that the Town of Inuvik acquires the said lands from the **Children First Society** of the Town of Inuvik in the Northwest Territories;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Municipal Corporation in the Northwest Territories, in council duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That the Mayor and the Senior Administrative Officer are hereby authorized on behalf of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Inuvik to acquire from the **Children First Society** for the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) the land described in hereunder:

Lot 16
Block 21
Plan 4317
Inuvik

2. This By-law shall come into effect upon the final day of passing.

READ A SECOND TIME THIS 12th DAY OF October, 2016 A.D.


