A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF INUVIK IN THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES TO AUTHORIZE THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF INUVIK TO REGULATE THE OPERATION OF CLASS A (LIQUOR PRIMARY) ESTABLISHMENTS WITHIN THE TOWN OF INUVIK ON SUNDAYS

**PURSUANT TO** the *Liquor Act* of the Northwest Territories, S.N.W.T. 2007, c.15 and the Northwest Territories Liquor Regulations as amended;

**WHEREAS** the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Inuvik deems it desirable to establish a Licensed Premises By-law;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Inuvik, in Council duly assembled, enacts as follows:

## **SHORT TITLE**

This by-law may be cited as the "Licensed Premises By-law".

### **APPLICATION**

2. A holder of a valid Class A (Liquor Primary) Licence, issued pursuant to the Northwest Territories *Liquor Act*, is hereby authorized to operate on Sundays from April 1 to November 30 each year between the hours of 15:00 and 00:00.

#### **EFFECT**

3. This by-law will come into effect thirty (30) days from receiving Third Reading and otherwise meets the requirements of Section 75 of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*.

#### REPEAL

4. By-law 2604/L+P/17 is hereby repealed.
